

4-H at Hawlemont

The Hawlemont 4-H program was started in 2014 to provide students after-school opportunities for more-in-depth exploration of concepts learned during HAY classes. Over the years we have offered 4-H project clubs in Baking, weaving, Animal Science, Robotics, Outdoor Adventure, Bugs, Mindfulness, Painting and Crafts.

Our clubs meet at Hawlemont from 3:15 to 5pm and usually meet only during the school year. We sometimes have opportunity to participating in 4-H fairs and other activities in the summer months.

Club Leaders are Cory checked and approved as Leaders by the local 4-H office. We are required to have at least 2 adults present during Club meetings.

The Hawlemont 4-H Clubs are organized under an umbrella club, the "Hawlemont 4-H Goat Club", which is a 501(c)(3) organization that manages the financial records, grant writing and tax filing for all the Hawlemont project clubs.

We need parents and interested volunteers to help and to become Club Leaders or Assistant Leaders.
